Ed was President of the London Solicitors Litigation Association in 2016/18, an association which represents the interest of over 2700 litigation solicitors in London. In June 2018, he was elected to the Law Society Council, representing the City of London with effect from September.

Ed has played a leading role for the profession on significant Court reform initiatives by participating as the solicitor representative on judge-led working groups, including the Shorter Trials Scheme, Rolls Building Working Group on the implications of Brexit for UK Civil Justice (2016) and the Disclosure Working Group: Ed, together with the Dame Elizabeth Gloster, Mr Justice Knowles, and Chief Master Marsh drafted the new rules on disclosure for cases proceeding in the Business & Property Courts in England & Wales. The disclosure reforms, which will take effect on 1 January 2019, will introduce an entirely new approach to disclosure by mandating greater co-operation and engagement between parties, increased use of technology in the data review process and more robust case management by the Courts."
