NexLP's Story Engine technology leverages the intellect and insight of co-founder Dr. Dan Roth— the winner of the AI 2017 John McCarthy Award, which is the “highest award the AI community gives to active researchers.” NexLP works with companies, governments and law firms to make unstructured and complex data sets not just more recognizable, but to create more well-rounded and complete statements of facts to solve problems and expose opportunities.

Jay has successfully founded and led software start-ups throughout his career. Prior to founding NexLP, he was the chief strategy officer at Chicago-based Relativity, a Chicago based software focused on eDiscovery.

He has more than a decade of experience in the technology field and has worked in multiple roles on some of the largest e-discovery and fraud investigation projects in the world.
